

# “How-To” find a listing on HomesOpen.Com

First, simply select a state from the main screen by clicking it:

Next, simply select the number of bedrooms you are interested in. There will be a random image, usually a recent addition showing. This does not mean you are selecting that listing.



On the next screen you will be looking for the actual listing you want to review. You can scroll and select a listing that you would like to view.



From the next screen, you can see detail of the listing you selected. You have the option to click the “S” and see a slide show from the category you are in. This could be a good screen saver while you are shopping for a home.



A good alternate if you have an idea of criteria you are looking for is to use the search function. You can see the “Search” button at the far right of the control bar. Clicking “Search” will open a window where you can fill in as much information as you like about the property you are seeking. Remember, less criteria will yield more results. The more specific you are, the less chance of a perfect match popping up. Also keep in mind that this is a service that is largely maintained by its users and 10 different people will describe the same property 10 different ways. So if you do not find the perfect listing from a search, remove some criteria and try again. A property with 2 bathrooms for instance someone may forget to enter that feature and you would miss it if 2 bathrooms is part of your search. Not to say don't use criteria, just don't count on it the way you would on a paid commercially maintained service.
